Guaranteed Admission Requirements:

Graduate from a GCC AA&S Transfer Program with a 2.5+ GPA. Guarantees completion of E&H's general education requirements. Maximum of 62 hours will transfer. GAA students entering without a religion course will be required to complete one at E&H. GAA students entering without credit for a two-semester sequence of foreign language will need to complete at E&H if required by their major. Acceptance in some degree programs (e.g. Athletic Training) is competitive and requires further acceptance by the program/department offering the program.

Applications are processed on a continuous basis.

Application Fee:

Waived for GAA students and online applicants.
