Private, for-profit online university. Regionally accredited. Primarily serves adult students. ACE-evaluated military training, corporate training, and work/life experience may translate into college credits. Ten week undergraduate terms. 14 "starts" for 2010 courses. Students take two courses at a time. May transfer in up to 76 semester credit hours. Most popular areas of study: Business and Management, Information Technology, Arts & Sciences. Operates on quarter credit system (1 quarter credit = 2/3 semester credit).

Guaranteed Admission Requirements:

Students completing an AA&S or AAS Associate's degree will be eligible for a block transfer of credits, junior status and acceptance into KU's "Advanced Start" bachelor completion program for transfer students. 10% tuition reduction. No application fee. Textbooks included in cost of undergraduate tuition. Transfer scholarships.
