## Profile:

Public, residential school with 4000 undergraduates located in Farmville (population: 7000), one hour from Richmond. Ranked #8 in "Top Public Universities-Master's" in the South by 2010 *U.S. News & World Report*. Majors with highest enrollment: business administration, elementary education and teaching, psychology, natural sciences.

## Guaranteed Admission Requirements:

Graduate from a GCC AA&S Transfer Program with a cumulative GPA of 2.5. Enter with junior status and General Educational Goals met. Minimum grade of C must be obtained for courses to transfer. D's will transfer only with AA&S. MTH 151 and 152 will transfer only with GAA. Some academic programs like education and business have their own GPA and pre-requisite requirements. Accepts CLEP if awarded credit at GCC. For students **completing** a transfer program and planning to enroll in a **B.S.** program at Longwood, no foreign language is required. However, **B.A.** programs at Longwood require foreign language through 202. For students not completing an AA&S, Longwood requires 30+ credits in college level English, math, science, and history.
