Guaranteed Admission Requirements:

Graduate from an AA&S transfer program with a 2.8+ GPA. Students will be granted junior status and will have satisfied RU's General Education requirements. There is no limit to number of hours a student may transfer. Grade transferability: C. Acceptance in some programs/departments at RU is competitive; further acceptance by the program/department offering the program is necessary. For regular admissions: students completing fewer than 30 credits must submit high school transcripts and SAT/ACT test results.
