## Guaranteed Admission Requirements:

Graduate from a GCC AA&S Transfer Program in Liberal Arts or General Studies. Students may transfer up to 96 quarter credit hours (approximately 64 semester credits). Personal interview with an Admissions representative required. Portfolio of artwork not required for admission. Students are to have completed their foundation courses at Germanna in Art History (Art 101 and 102), Drawing (Art 121 and 122), and Design (Art 131 and 132). Foreign language preferred but not required.
