Graduates from a GCC AA&S transfer program with a GPA of 2.0+. GAA students must have earned a grade of C or higher in each course applicable to the AA&S program. Some degree programs are competitive (Honors Program, School of Business, Teacher Education) and further acceptance by the program/department is necessary. Completion of General Education requirements and junior status are guaranteed.
